



We are excited that limited financial scholarships are available for some Quest campers this year! These scholarships are a result of the generosity of Family Communications, Inc., this year's winner of the Pursuer of Peace Award. Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come-first-served basis and only to campers who meet the criteria described below. Please note that all scholarship awards are contingent on Quest receiving the anticipated funding for this endeavor.

First-Time Campers

1. If your child is new to Quest, call Quest Director April Artz and arrange for a screening in order to determine whether or not your child is appropriate for Quest.
2. If your child has been deemed appropriate, s/he can only be considered for a partial scholarship if both of the following are met:
 - a. The child's household income is \$80,000 or less (according to 2014's 1040 tax form),

AND
 - b. The child is not eligible for Quest tuition payment by his/her school (ie ESY funding)
3. If #1 and #2 above have been satisfied, email a copy of your family's 2014 1040 tax form (first two pages only) to: info@squirrelhillpsych.org. Please write "Quest Scholarship Request" on the email's subject line.
4. Your family will be contacted once scholarship decisions have been made.

Returning Campers

1. If your child has attended Quest in the past (either summer or after school programs), no further screening is needed.

2. Your child can only be considered for a partial scholarship if both of the following are met:
 - a. The child's household income is \$80,000 or less (according to 2014's 1040 tax form),
AND
 - b. The child is not eligible for Quest tuition payment by his/her school (ie ESY funding)
3. If #1 and #2 above have been satisfied, email a copy of 2014's 1040 tax form (first two pages only) to: info@squirrelhillpsych.org. Please write "Quest Scholarship Request" on the email's subject line.
4. Your family will be contacted once scholarship decisions have been made.
